



Transparent Maintenance

Check List 03/30/2016

Superbike 1299 Panigale S - 2015

The **1,000 Km and 6 Months** service is the **Oil Service** .

The estimated service time is **2 hours and 30 minutes** and includes the following maintenance checks:

- ☐ Reading of the error memory with DDS 2.0 and check of software version update on control units (use the Global Scan function)
- ☐ Check the presence of any technical updates and recall campaigns
- ☐ Change engine oil and filter
- ☐ Check brake and clutch fluid level
- ☐ Check pad wear and brake discs. Change, if necessary
- ☐ Check of tightening of front and rear brake calliper screws and front brake disc screws
- ☐ Check front and rear wheel nuts tightening
- ☐ Check the proper tightening of final drive front and rear sprocket nuts
- ☐ Check final drive chain sliding shoe wear
- ☐ Check final Drive chain tension and lubrication
- ☐ Check silencer bracket retaining screw tightening
- ☐ Check water/oil heat exchanger retaining screw tightening
- ☐ Visual check of front fork and rear shock absorber seals
- ☐ Check the freedom of movement and tightening of the side stand
- ☐ Check rubbing points, clearance and freedom of movement of hoses and electric wiring on view
- ☐ Check coolant level
- ☐ Check tyre pressure and wear
- ☐ Check the battery charge level (from instrument panel menu)
- ☐ Check the operation of the safety electrical devices (side stand and clutch switch, front and rear brake switches, engine stop switch, gear/neutral sensor)
- ☐ Check lighting, turn indicators, horn and controls
- ☐ Reset the Service indication through the DDS 2.0
- ☐ Final test and road test of the motorcycle, testing safety devices (ex. ABS and DTC), electric fans and idling
- ☐ Softly clean of the motorcycle
- ☐ Fill out that the service was performed in on-board documentation (Service Booklet)

Times do not include any additional operation resulting from the failure to respect the set maintenance schedule, from vehicle usage conditions or from the presence of non-original spare parts. Always check your bike's service book to see what maintenance has already been carried out during previous servicing. All costs relating to maintenance servicing (labour and materials), including the first 1,000 kilometre/600 mile service, are borne by the Client. Carrying out the servicing in accordance with the terms indicated here below is essential for the retention of the guarantee.
